PROGRAMME INTRODUCTION

SheLEADS 2024 sparked an inspiring journey by bringing together twelve exceptional women leaders from diverse industries to redefine leadership. The participants came into the programme as individual leaders but emerged as accountability partners creating a dynamic collaborative network, and a dedication to mentor the next generation of women leaders.

Supported by the Embassy of Switzerland, this programme aimed to celebrate the inspiring success stories of Indian women leaders as India and Switzerland commemorate 75 years of bilateral relations.

The inaugural edition took place over two transformative days against the serene backdrop of Goa, focusing on selfintrospection, identifying barriers, and strategies for achieving life balance while building and leading teams. Participants engaged in open discussions, and heartfelt storytelling, and addressed real challenges within a space designed for reflection, connection, and the rediscovery of what it means to lead with purpose.

Each woman, a trailblazer in her own way, didn't just participate; she showed up with authenticity, vulnerability, and a genuine eagerness to share her journey, overcome barriers, and collectively imagine a future brimming with new possibilities.

When we created SheLEADS, our mission was to offer women leaders a powerful, transformative pause—a strategic opportunity to reflect, recharge, and reimagine their leadership journey while equipping them to build future-ready teams and organizations. Designed for women CEOs, founders, entrepreneurs, and senior managers, the programme provided a safe and supportive space for deep reflection, mentorship, and forging meaningful, lasting connections.

Despite the progress women have made, they are still significantly underrepresented in leadership across many sectors. Leading an organization is demanding for anyone, but women face distinct

challenges, from limited role models and cultural expectations to systemic barriers that can stifle their advancement. These hurdles often compel women to not only reimagine their roles but also to work harder to break through.

As women rise into leadership, mentoring others becomes easier, yet finding guidance for themselves can prove increasingly difficult. Leaders often dedicate so much time to supporting others that they may neglect their own needs, leading to burnout and a sense of isolation. This isolation can be further heightened by gender biases and societal expectations, particularly in maledominated industries.

With SheLEADS, we set out to do more than just celebrate individual achievements. Our goal was to bring together diverse voices, build a powerful network of leaders, and inspire collective action. These women shared remarkable stories of resilience, overcoming deeply rooted challenges and perceptions that often questioned their authority and leadership. Together, they became part of a movement—to reshape leadership and drive meaningful change.

While leadership can be a lonely place, it doesn't have to stay that way. By recognizing these challenges and actively building support, women are carving out their own paths, stepping out from behind the shadows and cultivating their unique brands and identities. When leaders embrace vulnerability and share the weight of responsibility with others, they find strength, connection, and resilience even in moments of solitude.

As we continue the SheLEADS journey, it's essential to focus on building strategic networks, embracing new challenges, and creating opportunities for other women to thrive. 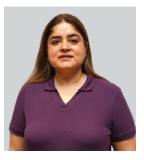

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

THE SheLEADS Programme empowered women to build skills and confidence in a supportive environment, transforming limiting beliefs into strengths and encouraging authentic leadership. It featured hands-on learning through discussions, reflections, video sessions, certified assessments, and personalized coaching, focusing on:

With over 30 years in global human resources, including her role as CHRO at SGS Group, Dominique brought international insights and expertise to the programme. After a leadership pause, Dominique founded Point North International to mentor business leaders worldwide. Her passion for mentoring, coupled with her extensive global leadership experience, made her the ideal mentor for our participants. For SheLEADS, Dominique tailored the programme for Indian audiences, addressing their unique needs and aspirations.



MAPPING PROGRAMME OUTCOMES

TO EVALUATE the impact of SheLEADS and improve future editions, we gathered feedback from our inaugural cohort. We asked the cohort to share their insights on their experiences, the programme's relevance, its impact on their growth, and suggestions for improvement.



75% of participants rated their **experience** as 4 or 5, showing a high level of satisfaction with SheLEADS.

91% felt the programme's **duration** allowed meaningful engagement while fitting into their busy schedules, making it practical and effective.





75% of respondents rated the **networking** opportunities as a 4 or 5, demonstrating the programme's effectiveness in supporting valuable connections.

A key measure of success was whether participants would **recommend** SheLEADS to other women leaders. An impressive **91%** expressed a strong willingness to do so, reflecting the programme's positive, transformative impact on growth, networking, and leadership development.

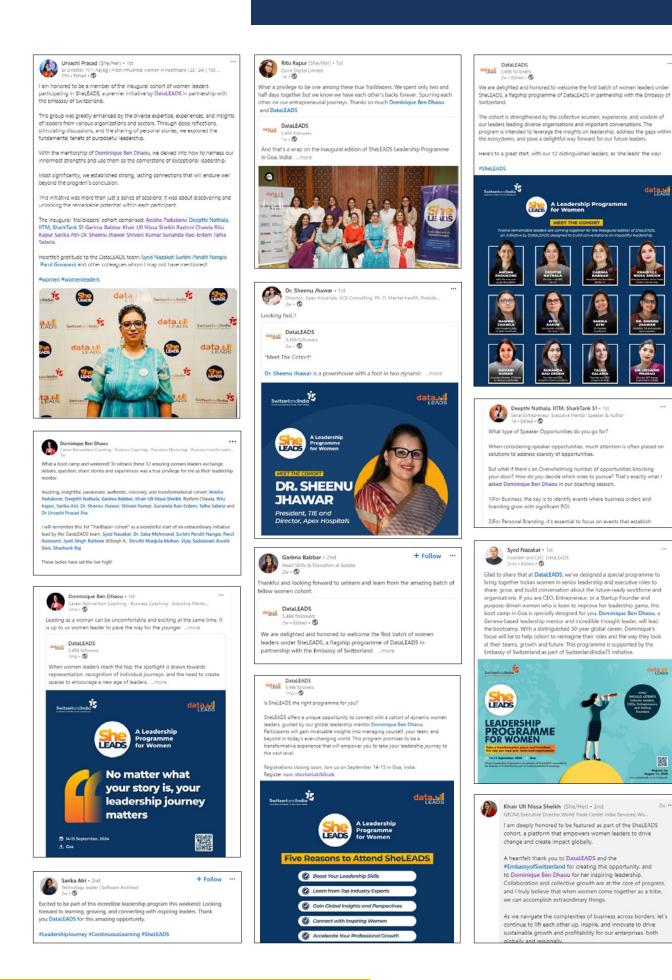

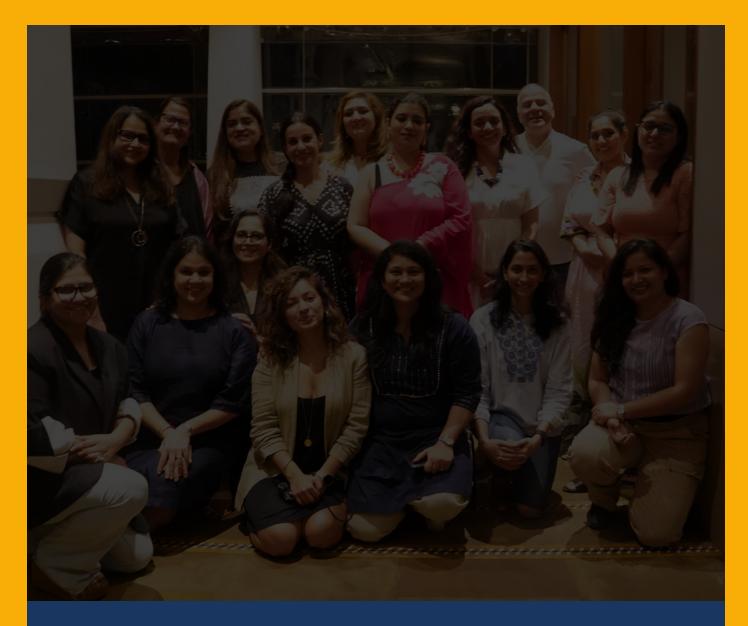
